Huber Disc Thickener Pilot Study Results

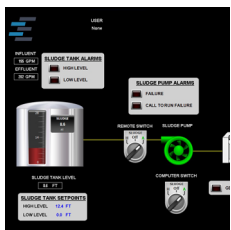


Disc Thickener pilot study for sludge thickening at the wastewater facility in Sister Bay, Wisconsin. This facility hauls their 1.0-1.5% treated biosolids to a larger municipality 30 miles away and was interested in learning if the HUBER Disc Thickener could reduce the volume and hauling costs. The study concluded that the optimal configuration

Fastest SCADA Upgrade in History?

A city in west central Wisconsin needed an upgrade to their SCADA network which consisted of a wastewater treatment plant, a water filter plant, two wells, one reservoir, and three lift stations. The project required a comprehensive upgrade of the control scheme across all of these plant operations and needed to be completed in five and a half months(!), driven by the requirements of their funding source.
