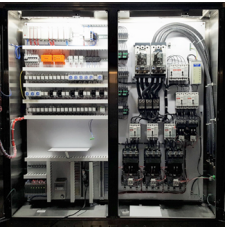

## Meet Don Miles CAD Technician

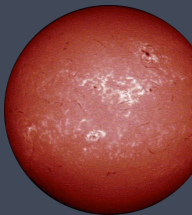


Don has been a Computer Aided Design (CAD) Technician at Energenecs since 2009.

At Energenecs he starts by getting a rough sketch drawing from a Project Manager, then provides a draft drawing which is given back to the PM to review. Their comments are incorporated into Submittal drawings for the consulting engineer or the end customer for changes or approval for a Production Release set. That set goes to the Energenecs UL shop for building. When the fabricators have completed the build, if there were any changes, he updates the drawings for the installers.

In his free time, Don is into astronomy and stargazing. He owns a simple telescope that's specifically for looking at spots on the sun!
