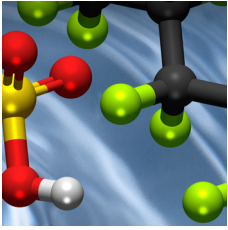


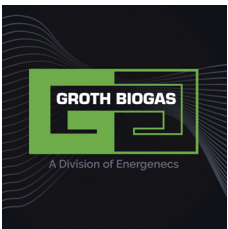
PFAS: What you need to know



PFAS are chemicals that resist grease, oil, water, and heat. They do not degrade easily, earning their nickname "the forever chemicals". The widespread use of PFAS and their persistence in the environment means that PFAS from past and current uses have resulted in increasing levels of contamination of the air, water, and soil.

On March 14, 2023, EPA announced the proposed National Primary Drinking Water Regulation for six PFAS and anticipates finalizing the regulation by the end of 2023. We spoke to Jim Groose, Senior VP of Business Development at WaterSurplus about solutions for removing PFAS from drinking water. Jim is an expert in water chemistry, groundwater treatment, municipal water treatment, and activated carbon and filtration. He discusses using a pressure filter with granular activated carbon or anion exchange resin and the differences between the two. Jim also goes over determining what can be done for long term solutions as well as renting a system for the short term to buy time and keep water production capacity up.
