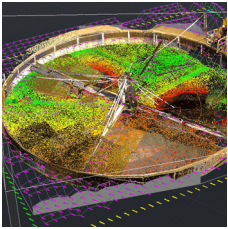


Revolutionizing Chain & Flight Sludge Collector Inspections with LiDAR Scanning

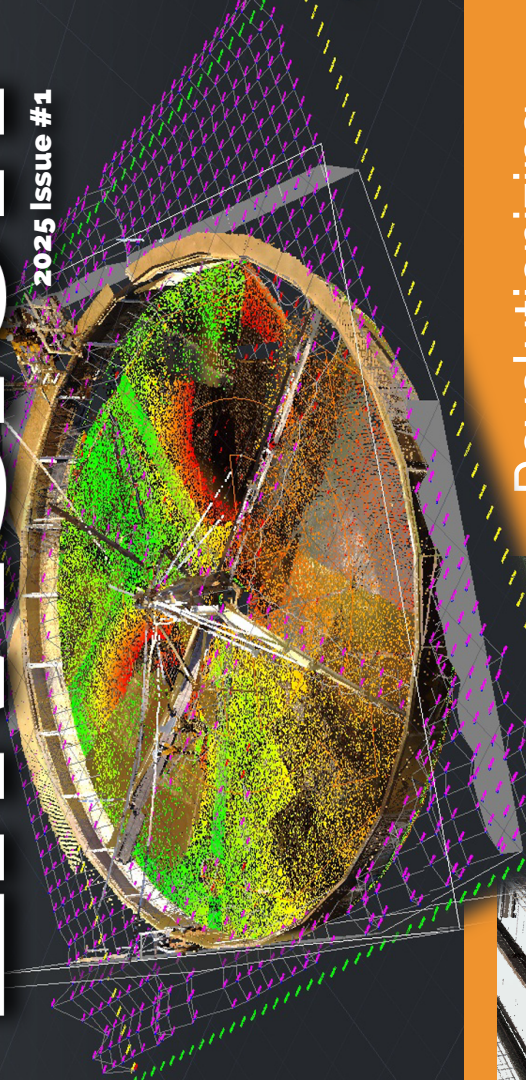

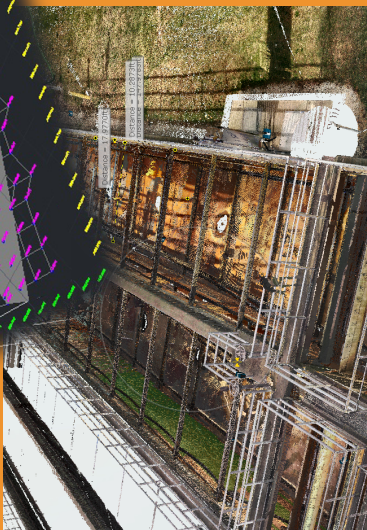
